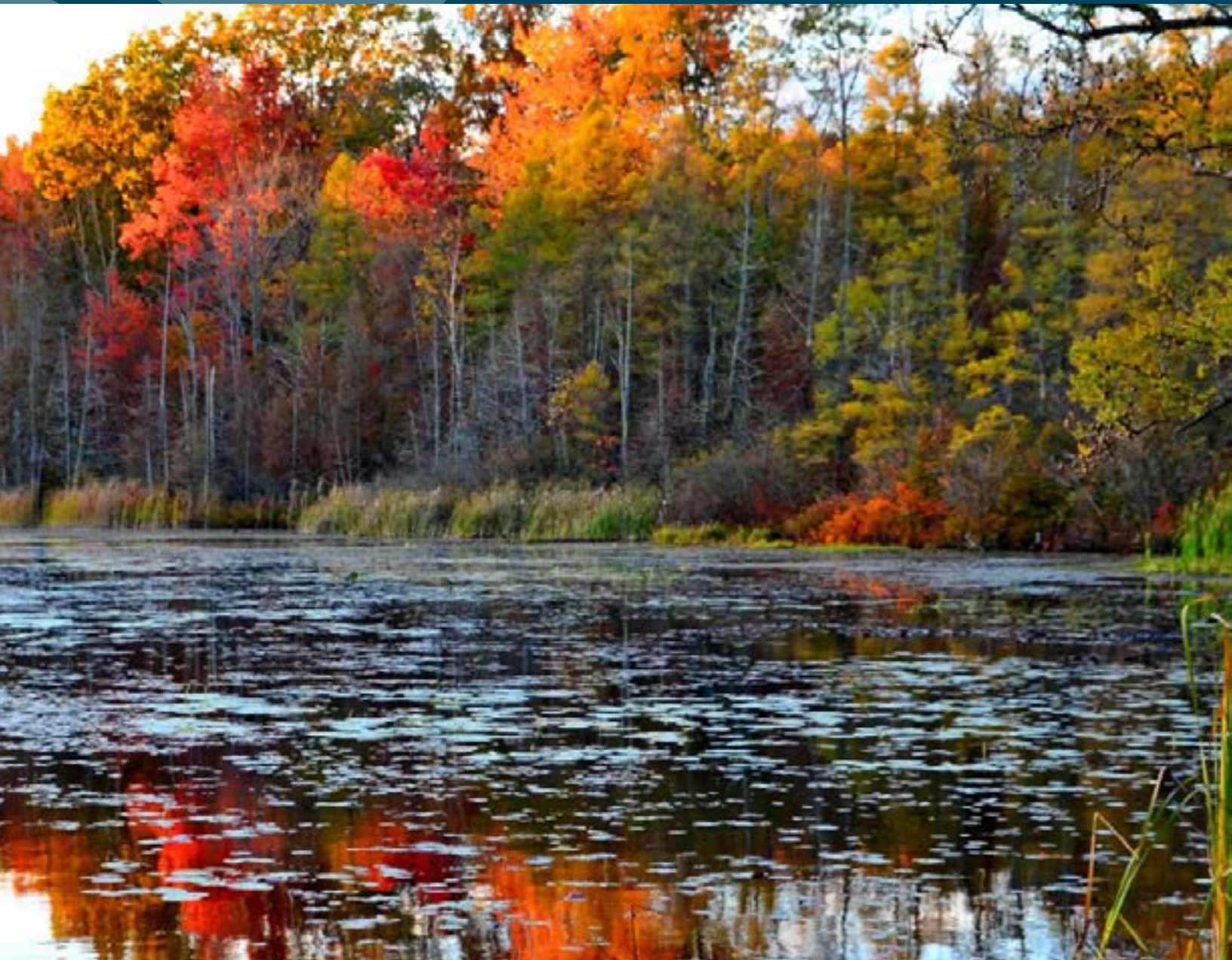

The USS Board recently adopted our DEI statement to represent our values and practices. We recognize this statement is a point of collective reflection, an embodiment of our ideals and vision, and a map to achieve our goals and mission. I am proud to share the USS Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion Statement with you.

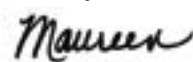
#### USS Diversity, Equity, Inclusion Statement:

The USS mission is a reflection of our commitment to eliminate ageist attitudes that diminish the value and dignity of older adults. We believe that the frailties associated with the gift of longevity be supported and honored, not feared nor disregarded. Our advocacy efforts are enhanced by our ongoing commitment to provide a diverse, equitable, and inclusive environment for all individuals in our sphere of influence regardless of age, race, gender, ability, religious belief, sexual orientation or expression, or economic circumstance. We unite with our community to correct social injustices or systemic discriminations that affect our ability to execute our mission. Advocating against systemic barriers and inequalities is an imperative of our stature in the community. We believe engaging people of all ages through our commitment to diversity, equity, and inclusion is essential to our mission and that DEI work is a source of strength, resilience, and hope for transforming ageist attitudes. We support ongoing efforts to improve our DEI competency. We commit resources and leverage key relationships to advance our DEI goals.

**Diversity** is defined as the full range of visible and invisible differences, backgrounds, and experiences that define each of us as human beings. **Equity** is defined as the fair treatment, respect, opportunity, and advancement for all people, while striving to identify and eliminate barriers to such treatment, opportunity, and advancement; providing the tools needed for success. **Inclusion** is defined as the systems, structures, and processes that promote a sense of belonging, connection, and community where all people feel known, welcomed, and valued. Ageism is defined as the casual or systemic stereotyping and discrimination against individuals or groups, especially the elderly, based on their age.

Thank you for your understanding of our COVID-19 safety practices as this pandemic continues. We recognize that EVERYONE is emotionally, physically, and sometimes financially affected. We are all bombarded by conflicting news reports, confused by changing COVID-19 safety protocols, and concerned for our loved ones. At USS, our employees spend a lot of time encouraging each other to keep their spirits up. I hope you are a part of a similar "encouragement circle." ## Medicare Open Enrollment

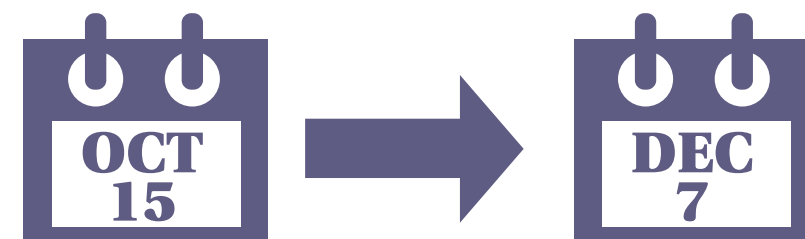
**Medicare Open Enrollment is October 15th - December 7th.**

Are you retiring, turning 65, or interested in a reevaluation of your current Medicare plan coverage? Medicare open enrollment is almost here! USS is excited to announce that in-person benefits counseling will once again be available in our centers in 2021. Counseling is available by appointment throughout open enrollment.

USS Benefits Counselor, Eric Demmings, will be available to assist those new to Medicare as well as those currently enrolled in Medicare and interested in reviewing alternative plans and benefits available during the open enrollment period. Eric provides Medicare beneficiaries with free, objective health insurance information, one-on-one counseling, and educates consumers about Medicare, Medicare prescription drug coverage (Part D), Medicare Advantage options, and Medicare supplement insurance.

Counselors from OSHIIP, a division of the Ohio Department of Insurance, will be on-site at the USS Downtown location on Tuesday, November 9th and Thursday, December 2nd. 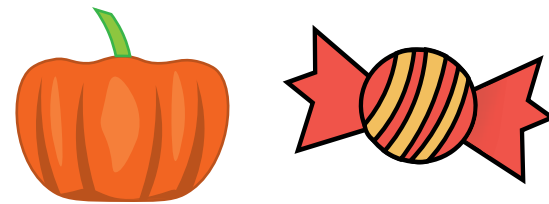
