Travel Insurance

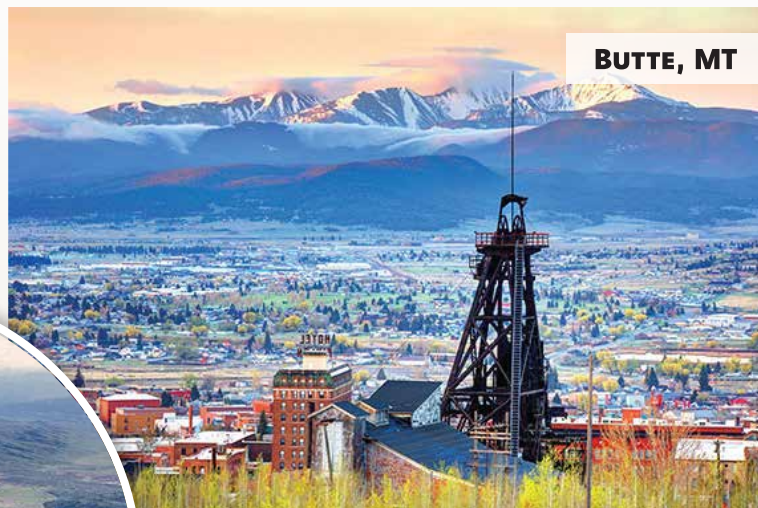

The premium for double occupancy is \$311 (age 60-74) or \$473 (age 75+). Single occupancy premium is \$394 (age 60-74) or \$599 (age 75+).

Refund Policy

Cancellations made prior to the final payment date are subject to a 5% processing fee of the payment received. Cancellations made after the final payment date are in full 100% penalty and non-refundable. 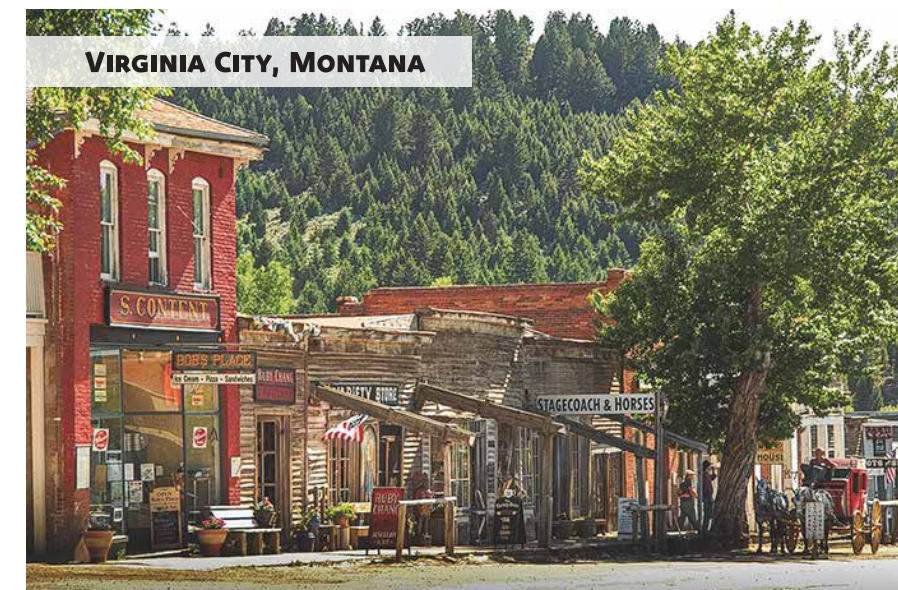

DAY 1:

Springfield, OH - Columbus, OH - Jackson Hole, WY
Your adventure begins by transferring to Port Columbus Airport for our flight to **Jackson Hole, Wyoming**. Upon arrival, we meet our motor coach and transfer to the mountain community town of Jackson Hole for a 2-night stay. The rest of the evening and dinner are at your leisure.

DAY 2:

Float Trip on the Snake River
Today we will explore the Tetons as we embark on a magnificent float trip with lunch included on the **Snake River**. This afternoon has been set aside for you to enjoy the Jackson Hole area at your leisure. Your hotel is 2 blocks from the Jackson Hole square. This evening, experience Jackson Holes' original **Chuck Wagon Dinner**. Traveling by horse drawn covered wagons, you are swept away from the town of Jackson into beautiful **Cache Creek Canyon**. With your own wrangler to guide you, they will drive your team of horses up the trail. As you pull into camp you can smell the sweet aroma of a Dutch oven dinner, to welcome your arrival. Enjoy this savory home-cooked meal as you go through the chow line. Then you can return all you want until we reach the

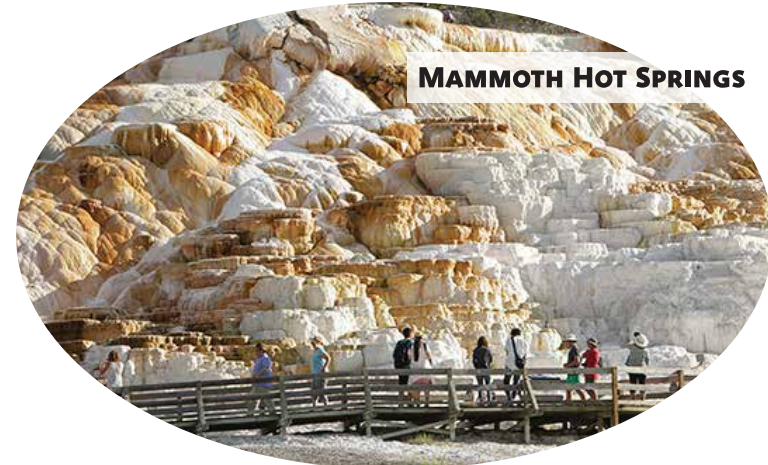
bottom of the pots. Afterwards, the Bar T 5 Band takes the stage to entertain you with laughter and great hand-clapping music. Have your camera ready because one of your fellow travelers may even end up on stage before the end of the night. **L, D**

DAY 3:

Grand Teton National Park - Yellowstone Nat. Park
From Jackson it is only a short drive to the Tetons, the youngest and most rugged mountains in America. As we explore **Grand Teton National Park**, we will stop at beautiful Jenny Lake and then visit the magnificent **Jackson Lake Lodge**. Just as you thought you could not see anything more spectacular, the Tetons are sure to mesmerize your spirit. Its soaring mountain peaks and glacial-fed lakes parallel the Swiss Alps. Afterwards, we continue our journey north into **Yellowstone National Park**. As we enter the south entrance of the park, we will traverse the Southern loop of the park where we will see the geothermal features of **Old Faithful**, West Thumb Geyser Basin and Yellowstone Lake. We arrive in West Yellowstone this evening for a 2-night stay at a hotel located just outside the park. Dinner is included this evening at the hotel. **D**

DAY 4:

Yellowstone National Park
After breakfast this morning, we continue our exploration of Yellowstone by traveling to the incredibly beautiful **Upper & Lower Loops**. Yellowstone is beyond special; it is the world's first national park. It is over 2.2 million acres of geysers, waterfalls, wildlife and scenic beauty packed inside an ancient caldera. Stop for a fascinating walking tour of the terraces at **Mammoth Hot Springs**, then view both the upper and lower falls at the **Grand Canyon of the Yellowstone**. After a full day of scenic beauty, we return to our hotel for the night. **B**

DAY 6:

Butte, Montana - Kalispell, Montana
Depart Butte for a short drive to **Deer Lodge** and the **Grant-Kohrs Ranch National Historic Site** commemorating the Western cattle industry from the 1850's to a working 1,600-acre ranch managed by the National Park Service. Arrive later this afternoon in **Kalispell, Montana** checking into our hotel for a 2-night stay. Dinner is included at a local favorite this evening. **B, D**

DAY 7:

Glacier National Park - Going to the Sun Highway
See **Glacier National Park** via the world famous "**Going-to-the-Sun Highway**," amid magnificent snowcapped peaks, gleaming lakes, and the virgin forests of the McDonald Valley aboard the historic Jammer coaches. **B**

DAY 8:

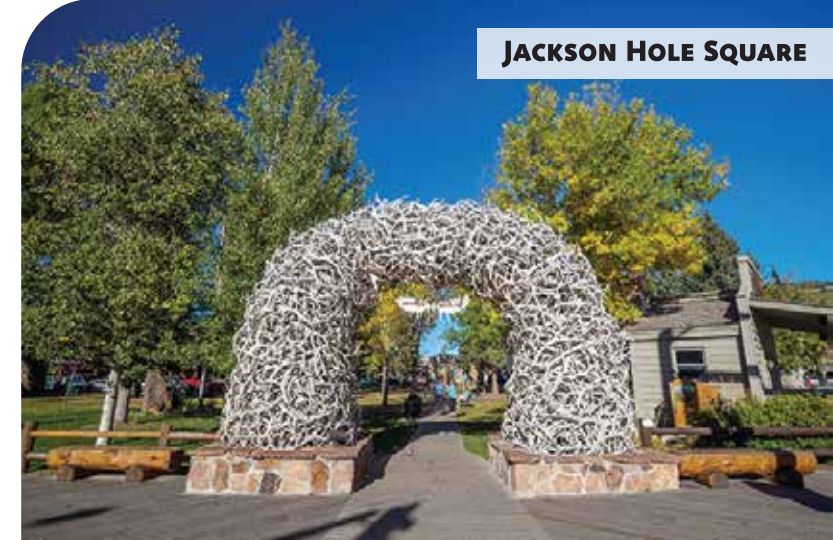
Kalispell, MT - Columbus, OH - Springfield, OH
