A \$500 deposit per person is due with your reservation form by May 8, 2026. First come, first served. Final payment is due no later than June 19, 2026.

DAY 1: Springfield, OH - Columbus, OH - overnight flight to Reykjavik

This afternoon we transfer to the Port Columbus Airport for our flight to Iceland. Our flight takes us overnight.

DAY 2: Arrive Reykjavik - local sights

Our plane arrives early this morning into **Reykjavik** where we will start our Iceland adventure with breakfast at a local restaurant before enjoying a guided visit to the National Museum of Iceland, where you'll explore the country's rich history and culture. Later, we check into our 4-star accommodations at Fosshotel Reykjavik for a two-night stay. We join tonight as a group for a welcome dinner at a local favorite. **B, D**

DAY 3: Iceland's South Shore

Today, journey along Iceland's spectacular South Shore, experiencing some of the country's most dramatic natural wonders. Marvel at the stunning **Seljalandsfoss** waterfall, where you can walk behind the cascading water, and the mighty **Skógafoss**, known for its powerful flow and frequent rainbows. We continue to **Reynisfjara Black Sand Beach**, famed for its striking basalt columns and the towering sea stacks rising from the ocean. Afterwards, we visit the **Geothermal Energy Exhibition** at Hellisheiði and the **Skógar Folk Museum** offering insight into Iceland's sustainable energy and rural past. We return to the hotel this evening where the rest of the evening and dinner are at your leisure. **B**

DAY 4: Reykjavik - Reykholt

Depart Reykjavik and travel north toward Reykholt, with a stop at the remarkable **Thingvellir National Park** - a UNESCO World Heritage Site and one of Iceland's most important cultural and geological landmarks. Walk between two tectonic plates and learn about the site of the world's first parliament. After a scenic day of exploration, we arrive in the peaceful village of **Reykholt** and check into our hotel for a 2-night stay. Enjoy a relaxing evening with dinner served at the hotel. **B, D**

DAY 5: Snæfellsnes Peninsula

Today, set out on a full-day excursion to the stunning **Snæfellsnes Peninsula**, often called "Iceland in Miniature" for its diverse landscapes. From dramatic coastlines and volcanic peaks to charming fishing villages and lava fields, this region showcases the natural beauty and geological variety of Iceland. In the afternoon, visit the **Settlement Center Exhibition** in Borgarnes to delve into the stories of Iceland's earliest inhabitants. Return to your hotel in Reykholt for a relaxing evening and enjoy dinner at the hotel. **B, D**

DAY 6: Whale Watching Excursion - Northern Lights Tour

Begin your day with a visit to the **Whales of Iceland** exhibition, where life-sized models and interactive displays offer a fascinating insight into the country's marine life. Whales of Iceland is the largest whale museum in Europe, featuring 23 life-sized models of whale species found in Icelandic waters. Each model is based on an individual whale and showcases intricate details, including unique markings.

Afterwards, we take a 3-hour journey into **Faxaflói Bay** with an expert crew and specially trained marine biologist guides on a whale watching cruise. Later, check back into the Fosshotel Reykjavik before gathering with your group for a special farewell

dinner. In the evening, set out on a magical Northern Lights tour in search of Iceland's famous aurora borealis—an unforgettable way to end your journey. **B, D**

DAY 7: Blue Lagoon - Fly home

Enjoy a relaxing and memorable final day in Iceland as your trip comes to a close. This morning, we depart from Fosshotel Reykjavik for a comfortable private transfer to Keflavik International Airport.

En route to the airport, you'll stop at the world-famous **Blue Lagoon**, one of Iceland's most iconic attractions. Set within a dramatic lava field, the Blue Lagoon is renowned for its milky-blue, mineral-rich geothermal waters. Enjoy time to soak and unwind in the warm lagoon, surrounded by stunning volcanic scenery. The silica and algae in the water are known for their rejuvenating properties, making this the perfect way to relax before your flight home.
