DAY 1:

We depart this morning to drive the length of Ohio passing through the Bluegrass State into the Volunteer State of Tennessee. Arriving in Nashville we check into the Embassy Suites for a 4-night stay. Enjoy a "Welcome to the Tour" dinner this evening. **D**

DAY 2:

After breakfast at the hotel, walk in the footsteps of legends with a tour of the historic **RCA Studio B**. Hear inside details from the famous recording sessions; learn about the timeless tools of the trade, from microphones to a Steinway piano that Elvis favored, and hear hits in high-fidelity, right where they were born. Next, the **Country Music Hall of Fame**, the gateway to the history of country music. You will see a huge wall featuring every gold or platinum record to ever top the charts as well as exhibits showcasing the talents of the legends of country music.

Afterwards, this afternoon is yours to explore Nashville's Honky Tonk Highway, the heart of the country music scene, a four-block stretch of Broadway Street with a row of honky tonks pumping live music all day. Rejoin as a group

this evening at **Puckett's General Store**, one of Downtown Nashville's top restaurants featuring "Southern Style" cooking for an included dinner. **B, D**

DAY 3:

Following breakfast, we board our motor coach and drive a short distance to the **Opry House** for a Grand Ole **Opry Backstage Tour** to go behind the scenes of the venue that made country music famous. You will walk through the artist entrance, view uniquely themed dressing rooms, the mailroom, learn artist history and step onto the main stage where all the dreams turned into reality. Next, we will board the stern-wheeler showboat **General Jackson** and enjoy a lunch and show. The high-energy stage show features live performances of iconic hits from country greats and bluegrass pioneers to rock 'n' roll favorites. With dazzling costumes, powerhouse vocals, and a live band, each performance brings the spirit of Music City to life on the Cumberland River on Nashville's only paddlewheel showboat.

This evening, enjoy dinner in an authentic Southern dining destination - **Paula Deen's Family Kitchen**. Top off the evening with the Thursday night performance of the **Grand Ole Opry**. The Grand Ole Opry is a legendary live variety show and the longest-running radio broadcast in U.S. history. It showcases a dynamic mix of country music superstars, rising talent, and comedy acts. The show is famous for its intimate, rotating lineup and the iconic wooden circle on its stage. **B, L, D**

DAY 4:

Enjoy a hearty breakfast this morning before we board our motor coach and travel a short distance to the **Belle Meade Historic Site and Winery**. Here, you will enjoy a guided tour of the 1853 Greek Revival Mansion and overview of Belle Meade as a thoroughbred stud farm. A wine tasting is included.

Next we travel to Lynchburg, Tennessee and the **Jack Daniels Distillery**. Small town values and perfect Americana living are alive and well in Lynchburg, a small town of 5,500 or so residents tucked away in the rolling hills of Moore County Tennessee. It might be small, but it's home to one large industry – the Jack Daniels Distillery – which is the oldest registered distillery in the United States and averages over 250,000 visitors every year. Every ounce of Jack Daniels Tennessee Whiskey is produced here, fed by the pure, iron-free cave water springs nearby. See firsthand how Tennessee whiskey is carefully crafted, all while learning more about the founder – Mr. Jack. You'll be treated to a story-filled, guided walk through the historic distillery, concluding with a taste of six different Jack Daniel Tennessee Whiskey samples. After our visit, enjoy some free time to explore the shops in downtown Lynchburg. Later in the afternoon we return to Nashville and enjoy dinner at a local favorite. **B, D**

DAY 5:

Enjoy breakfast and a leisurely morning as your bags are being loaded onto the motor coach. We depart the hotel and start the journey back to Ohio taking with us memories of Nashville's rich southern hospitality and its vibrant, energetic music influences. **B**

Payment policy:

Refund policy:
